Family Registration Fees - Fall 2026 & Winter 2027

For families new to the program, the fee remains \$50 until Oct 1 (for 1 or more children).

- **Family Registration Fees** are required each year for all families, and are paid when you register for the season through our website.
- **Tuition Fees** are invoiced before the start of each term. Various payment plans and methods are available.
- ***All Tuition Fees listed below are charged in addition to the Registration Fees (.ie. registration fees are not subtracted).**

Group Classes with STEP

- Where:** Memorial University's School of Music
- When:** Saturday mornings, between 9:00am-12:30pm
- What's Included:** Fall & Winter Fees cover 18 weeks of classes from Sept-April. Additionally, participation in 2 group class concerts among other social & musical events at STEP. For Core Suzuki Curriculum students, this also includes participation in 2 solo concerts & 1 yearly graduation concert.
- Private Lessons:** Scheduled directly with your private teacher, and fees for private lessons are paid directly to the teacher in accordance with their studio policies.
- When you register:** You will provide all the info needed for us to place you/your child in the appropriate classes for your/your child's age, level, and experience. Class placements are made considering all of these factors, and in consultation with private teachers and recent group class teachers.

Tuition Fees - Fall 2026 & Winter 2027

Core Suzuki Curriculum Packages (Violin, Viola, Cello, Guitar)

Pre-Twinkle, Twinkle, & Book 1 Packages: includes a weekly 30-min instrumental group class and 30-min musicianship class.

Parent Orientation: includes a weekly 30-min seminar. Mandatory for new families in the first year your child starts lessons and classes on their instrument, and is open to families who have already completed the course. This class takes place in-person on Saturday mornings, and childcare is provided so parents can attend.

Book 2, 3, & 4 Packages: includes a weekly 45-min instrumental group class and 30-min musicianship class (up to the completion of Musicianship Green). *Reading Orchestra is recommended upon completion of Musicianship Green.*

\$485 up to Musicianship Green/\$425 after completion of Musicianship Green

Book 5 & Up Packages: includes a weekly 60-min instrumental group class. *Young Virtuosi or Reading Orchestra recommended.*

Enrichment Classes (Violin, Viola, Cello)

Students not registered in a Core Suzuki Curriculum Package are welcome to join us for Enrichment classes as Community Students! Separate fees are reflected below to account for program overhead already factored into the Core Package fees.

Reading Orchestra: includes a weekly 45-min group class, for students who have completed Musicianship Green.

\$245 for Core Suzuki Curriculum students/\$345 for Community Students

Junior & Intermediate Fiddle: includes a weekly 30-min group class. *Private teacher recommendation required for Junior Fiddle registration.*

\$215 for Core Suzuki Curriculum students/\$315 for Community Students

Senior Fiddle: includes a weekly 45-min group class.

\$245 for Core Suzuki Curriculum students/\$345 for Community Students

Early Childhood Education (ECE) Classes - No instruments needed

Music With Your Baby/Infant/Toddler: (ages 0 to ~2.5 years): includes a weekly 30-min group class.

***Free tuition for babies up to 6 months - only pay the family registration fee!**

Transitions: (ages ~2.5 to ~3.5 years): includes a weekly 30-min group class.

Music & Movement (ages ~3 to ~6 years): includes a weekly 30-min group class. This class is included in the Pre-Twinkle/Twinkles package, but can be taken as a standalone class if you would like more time in the program before starting on an instrument.

Performing Ensembles (Violin, Viola, Cello)

Young Virtuosi: By invitation - weekly 75 min rehearsals on Saturdays, following the Fall/Winter and Spring Schedule

Young Virtuosi Initiates: By invitation - YVI students will participate in 4 rehearsals and some concerts throughout the year. Reading Orchestra is recommended.

\$100 for Core Suzuki Curriculum students/\$150 for Community Students

Classes for Adults

Depending on scheduling and room availability, some adult classes may take place on other days or at other locations - participants will be contacted if this may apply to their chosen classes, and suitable times will be chosen with participants. If the scheduling does not work out, your registration fee will be refunded.

Beginner/Intermediate Fiddle: includes a weekly 45-min group class, open to adults with any experience on violin/fiddle, classes to be grouped by level and experience.

Learn the Violin: includes a weekly 45-min group class, open to adults with any experience on violin, classes to be grouped by level and experience.

Learn the Cello: includes a weekly 45-min group class, open to adults with any experience on cello, classes to be grouped by level and experience.

Learn the Guitar: includes a weekly 45-min group class, open to adults with any experience on guitar, classes to be grouped by level and experience.

***New* Chamber Groups:** includes a weekly 30-min group class, participants will be placed in groups of 3-4, and appropriate repertoire will be selected to work on during the year, coached by a STEP teacher.

***New* Body Mapping:** includes a weekly 30-min group class, with Body Mapping expert Lauren Smee.

Gain a better sense of your own body and how that influences your playing! Body Mapping can be used to improve posture, comfort, ease of playing, and tone (!), along with prevention of injury.
